University students will discuss the Baltic Sea and health at European Forum

The European Forum will take place this year as a largely streamed webcast. It will start on 27 of August. The programme, produced by University of Turku students, focuses on the health cluster and the Baltic Sea.

The theme of the Baltic Sea as a changing operating environment for companies will be presented. Magnus Gustafsson, Research Manager at Åbo Akademi University's Industrial Management Laboratory, Tomi Solakivi, Assistant Professor of Supply Chain Management at the University of Turku, and Elina Andersson, Managing Director of the Finnish Maritime Industry Association, will participate in the discussion moderated by Toni Ahlqvist, Research Director of the University's Future Research Center. After that, a joint university debate will start. The topic is: "Everyone wants to protect the Baltic Sea - why is the sea not getting better? Regulation and management of the marine environment". The moderator is Nina Tynkkynen, Assistant Professor of Research at Åbo Akademi University's Marine Profiling Project, and the speakers are Professor Henrik Ringbom, a lawyer working at both the University of Turku and Åbo Akademi University, Member of the European Parliament Sirpa Pietikäinen, Environment Director for Agriculture and Forestry Liisa Pietola and State Secretary Terhi Lehtonen, Ministry of the Environment.

Other topics for discussion: Democracy in Emergencies - what can EU crises teach us; European Youth section on "Is the EU a great power?"; EU-China relations; EU's global role in 2050 and EU-Africa relations; European Union and Finland's position in Europe.

University of Latvia has established cooperation with the global development and education organization IREX, which strives for a fairer and more inclusive world. **In cooperation with six Baltic universities**, IREX is working on media literacy programmes to help young people be able to critically evaluate information in the media. One of the partners is the Faculty of Social Sciences of the University of Latvia, where under the guidance of professionals, students will have the opportunity to improve media literacy and understanding of journalism quality, importance and challenges in the current information age.

The collaboration takes place in two stages - **online summer study programme "Three Stories of Media Literacy"** (where students are to learn more about media literacy and improve their critical thinking skills) and **a new study course "Journalism in the Age of Disinformation"** (which is to cover topics such as misinformation in the media, the role of the media and quality journalism today, the methods used by fact-checkers to check information, the recognition of stereotypes in media content).

GDANSK UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

Gdańsk University of Technology in Shanghai Ranking for the first time

Gdańsk University of Technology was included in prestigious Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), also known as the Shanghai Ranking, for the first time. Eight Polish universities are among the top 1 000 universities from around the world. Gdańsk University of Technology fell into the range of 801-900, ahead of 2 other Polish universities. Among Polish universities, 8 were classified in this year's edition of the ranking (9 Polish universities qualified for last year's edition). Two other Polish universities were also classified in the same range as GUT – the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań and the Warsaw University of Technology. Only 3 Polish universities were classified in higher places - the University of Warsaw (301-400), the Jagiellonian University (401-500) and the AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow (701-800).

MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF GDANSK

Innovation Incubator 4.0

Medical University of Gdańsk has obtained funding for the implementation of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education programme called Innovation Incubator 4.0. The funds come from non-competitive project Support for the management of scientific research and commercialization of R&D results in research units and enterprises, implemented under the Intelligent Development Operational Programme 2014-2020.

The unit implementing the Innovation Incubator 4.0 programme, on the side of the University, is the Technology Transfer Center. The project will be implemented in a consortium led by MUG and consortium members: University of Gdańsk and the MUG's special purpose vehicle - Medical Innovation Center. The cofinancing granted to the consortium amounts to PLN 1.9 million. The project implementation period will last until 31 December, 2022.

NB: The subject of the Innovation Incubator 4.0 program is to support entities of the higher education and science system in the implementation of projects aimed at applying the results of scientific research in the economic or social sphere.

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UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW

Meeting of rectors on cooperation between University of Warsaw and Medical University of Warsaw

On 24 August, a meeting of representatives of University of Warsaw and Medical University of Warsaw took place. It was attended by the rectors and vice-chancellors of both universities of the current term of office, as well as new rector's teams of both universities, who will start working in September. The talks focused on the development of scientific and didactic cooperation between universities.

Two universities have been developing joint research and teaching projects for years. Universities have launched a program of inter-university classes and a micro-grants program for conducting joint research financed from external funds. In 2018-2020, under the micro-grants program, scientists received funding for 27 joint projects.

Increasing the international importance of the University of Warsaw thanks to the development of cooperation with the Medical University of Warsaw is one of the main objectives of the "Initiative of Excellence - Research University" program, for which the University of Warsaw received funding in October 2019 in the Ministry of Science and Higher Education competition.

During the meeting held on 24 August at University of Warsaw, the rectors discussed the development of joint initiatives launched in previous years and confirmed their interest in continuing the strategic cooperation of both universities. They analyzed the current state of cooperation and the issues related to the possibility of federalization. The concept of the federation and the draft of its statute were developed in 2019, positively assessed by the rector authorities, Senates and University Councils of the University of Warsaw and the Medical University of Warsaw, and submitted for arrangements with the Ministry of Science and Higher Education. The Ministry positively assessed the proposed federation model. Its implementation requires an amendment to the act, which is favorable for the Ministry of Science.

HERZEN STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF RUSSIA

More than 100 foreign teachers of Russian language and literature have been trained at Herzen University

From 10 to 21 August, at Herzen University, with the support of Rossotrudnichestvo, the Committee for External Relations of St. Petersburg and the Russky Mir Foundation, advanced training courses "Modern Trends in the Methodology of Teaching Russian as a Foreign Language" were held for teachers living abroad.

This year, the training took place online – this made it possible to expand the geography of participants: it united 103 participants from 48 countries including Albania, Argentina, Brazil, Great Britain, Vietnam, Greece, Egypt, Iceland, Italy, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Lebanon, Lithuania, Morocco, Mongolia, Palestine, Poland, Syria, Tajikistan, France, Sri Lanka and others.

For two weeks, the participants listened to a 72-hour course of lectures and practical exercises on Zoom platform on contemporary Russian culture (literature, cultural linguistics, regional studies) and methods of teaching Russian as a foreign language and literature, as well as mastered the practical course of RFL.

PSKOV STATE UNIVERSITY

Pskov State University won a grant for research in the field of physics of materials of the future – nanocomposites

The Russian Foundation for Basic Research (RFBR), following the results of the Postgraduate Students competition, supported an application for the project "Experimental investigation of porous matrix types and conditions of their filling with iodine and silver nanoparticles effect on the electrical and optical properties of nanocomposites" submitted by Pskov State University.

The main goal of this work is experimental and theoretical study of physical phenomena (size effects, phase transitions, etc.) in nanocomposites based on regular porous dielectric matrices (opals, zeolites, porous aluminum oxide, asbestos, and others). This approach makes it possible to solve the urgent problem of obtaining new nanocomposite materials with improved electrical and optical properties, which is of great importance in photonics, plasmonics, electronics, and materials science.

ST. PETERSBURG ELECTROTECHNICAL UNIVERSITY

LETI university entered the TOP-100 of the best universities according to Forbes for the third time

Forbes has published a rating of the 100 best universities in Russia, prepared to assess the quality of Russian education and identify universities whose graduates in future may become members of the Forbes list or enter the country's political elite.

St. Petersburg State Electrotechnical University took 38th place in the ranking. New parameters were introduced into the metric "Quality of education", based on the data of monitoring the effectiveness of educational institutions of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia: "Quality of teachers" (takes into account the salary level of the teaching staff, the ratio of teaching staff and students, the share of foreign teachers) and "International activity" (includes the share of foreign students, the share of students who studied abroad for at least a semester, as well as the program of Double diplomas).

The indicators of the Graduate Quality metric were formed on the basis of Forbes' own research conducted in conjunction with the Avito Rabota service. Representatives of 59 employing companies told which graduates of which universities they hired over the past two years, which of them received a promotion or salary during these two years, and graduates of which universities they consider the most prepared.

The Forbes Factor metric took into account the university's presence in the QS and THE rankings. The list of well-known alumni and students includes only the children of participants in the list of 200 richest businessmen in Russia, as well as nominees for the Forbes rating of young and successful Russians "30 to 30".

According to analysts, an increase in the share of foreign teaching staff, an increase in the share of students who have undergone foreign internships, as well as the development of double degree programs will contribute to improving the university's position in the ranking.

St. Petersburg State University continues to occupy high positions in the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), or Shanghai Ranking, which today is considered the oldest and one of the most respected global rankings of universities in the world. This year, St. Petersburg State University again entered the 301–400 group, yielding superiority among Russian higher educational institutions only to the Lomonosov Moscow State University. In total, the ranking list of 2020 includes 11 Russian universities, ranked in the fifth hundred and below.
