UNIVERSITY OF TURKU

Nearly EUR 2 million of funding is granted for the spatial education development project coordinated by the University of Turku

The GeoICT4e project, coordinated by University of Turku, has received funding of almost EUR 2 million from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the development of spatial data training for social innovations in Tanzanian universities.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has granted a total of EUR 11.2 million of funding for four-year university partnerships. The HEI ICI (Higher Education Institutions Institutional Cooperation Instrument) supports cooperation projects between Finnish and developing countries universities.

The largest funding went to the GeoICT4e project, coordinated by the Department of Geography and Geology at the University of Turku, which focuses on reforming the spatial and ICT education of Tanzanian universities. The co-operation project between three Finnish and five Tanzanian universities aims to change the functionality of education so that it produces solution-oriented spatial data experts for the digital labor market of the future.

UNIVERSITY OF LATVIA

UL studies the impact of Covid-19 pandemic on Latvia's national economy

Within the framework of the State Research Program, the Latvian Science Council will finance University of Latvia's research project "Economic, Political and Legal Framework for Preserving the Potential of the Latvian Economy and Promoting Competitiveness Growth after a Pandemic Crisis (reCOVery-LV)". The project manager is UL professor Inna Šteinbuka.

An interdisciplinary team of researchers from the University of Latvia, the Latvian Academy of Sciences, the Latvia University of Agriculture, Riga Stradiņš University and Riga Technical University will be involved in the development of the project.

The aim of the project is to provide a comprehensive and multidisciplinary impact assessment of the Covid-19 pandemic on the Latvian economy and to prepare scientifically based and innovative interdisciplinary policy recommendations for better coping with the pandemic challenges to sustainable and inclusive development of the Latvian economy.

GDANSK UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

Gdańsk University of Technology is in the 4th place among technical universities and in the top ten of the best universities in the country in the "Perspektywy" ranking

In the latest edition of the ranking of universities by the Educational Foundation "Perspektywy", Gdańsk University of Technology took fourth place among technical universities (ex equo with the Lodz University of Technology) and eighth place among all universities in the country.

In the overall ranking, the Jagiellonian University is at the forefront of the ranking, followed closely by the University of Warsaw. The third place was taken by the Warsaw University of Technology. The highest position among Tri-City universities was taken by the Medical University of Gdańsk (6th place), while the Gdańsk University of Technology was the second Pomeranian university (8th place).

In turn, in the classification of Polish technical universities, GUT was again 4th, behind the Warsaw University of Technology, the AGH University of Science and Technology in Kraków and the Wrocław University of Technology. The fourth position was awarded ex equo - as in the previous year - also to the Lodz University

of Technology. The university in Gdańsk was ahead of, among others Poznań, Silesian and Lublin University of Technology.

For the last four years, she was the University of Lodz Vice-Rector for Science.

IMMANUEL KANT BALTIC FEDERAL UNIVERSITY

Immanuel Kant Baltic Federal University is in the TOP-500 of the best universities in Europe in the publication activity rating Nature Index

Springer Nature Publishing House has published the annual Nature Index publication activity for 2019. The ranking reflects the publication activity of scientific institutions around the world based on the analysis of articles in 82 prestigious scientific journals, selected by an independent group of scientists and monitored by the Nature Index database.

In the context of academic institutions (Top Academic Institutions 2020) Immanuel Kant University took the 475th place in Europe (+24 positions) and 21st in Russia (+6 positions), thereby significantly improving its positions compared to last year and bypassing such universities as the Bauman Moscow State Technical University, Sechenov Moscow State Medical University, RUDN, Far Eastern Federal University and Siberian Federal University.
