Francisk Skorina Gomel State University

Francisk Skorina GSU took the 4th place among Belarusian universities in the new Webometrics ranking, and also became the first among regional institutions of higher education. GSU occupies 3608 place in the world ranking and is included in 12% of the best educational institutions. In total, about 30 000 institutions of higher education are taken into account in the ranking. The main assessment criteria are the university's presence in the Internet and the citation of scientific publications.

Business Finland has granted EUR 3 million in funding for the PRIVASA project led by the University of Turku, which is developing artificial intelligence methods for the safe utilization of sensitive materials in the health sector. The project involves e.g. Turku University of Applied Sciences, VTT, PerkinElmer, BCB Medical and several other companies.

The aim of the project is to accelerate the product development of companies operating in international markets by producing anonymous, individual-level health data for the needs of companies' development and innovation activities. Gdansk University of Technology

MUG is the most internationalized university in Pomerania. It is the most frequently chosen university by foreign students studying in Gdansk. Long-standing trend is confirmed by latest report Studenci zagraniczni w Polsce 2020 (Foreign students in Poland 2020) prepared under the programme Study in Poland implemented by the Conference of Rectors of Academic Schools in Poland and Educational Foundation Perspektywy (Perspectives). There are 3 270 foreigners studying in Gdansk who are coming from 44 countries. The most numerous group is MUG students — over 30% of the total number.
