Gdansk University of Technology

In this year's edition of the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2021, GUT was classified in two disciplines out of five broad scientific areas: Chemistry and Engineering - Electrical & Electronic. GUT was for the first time included in the Chemistry discipline in the 451-500 range and for the second time in the discipline Engineering-Electrical & Electronic, increasing from 451-500 range to 401-450. The authors of the ranking analysed over 3 800 study programmes at over 1 440 universities.

The new building will host the departments of the University of Warsaw: the Faculty of Applied Social Sciences and Resocialisation and the Faculty of Sociology. Two units of the Polish Academy of Sciences were also invited to share the building under direct scientific cooperation: the Institute of Philosophy and Sociology and the Institute of Political Studies.

At the end of the event, an International Competition for Young Architects "LETI - Academic Environment of the Future" was announced. Its participants will develop projects to transform four iconic locations on the LETI campus into new interactive spaces for study, work, communication and outdoor activities.

ETU "LETI" showed an increase in its performance indicators in the THE Emerging Economies University Rankings. The university retained its place in the 301-350 group and was ranked 21st among Russian universities. ETU "LETI" showed the greatest increase in Industry Income indicators, compared to last year - from 54.7 to 60.7 points. It allowed the university to come close to the top 100 universities included in the rankings and take 15th place among Russian universities by this criterion.
