

Abstracts of reports and applications for participation in the conference should be submitted to the organizing committee before April 01, 2023. Manuscripts of papers for the Vestnik of NovSU should be submitted to the Organizing Committee by May 19, 2023.

There is no fee for publishing both abstracts in the book of abstracts and extended materials of the conference in Vestnik NovSU.

RULES FOR THE ABSTRACTS FORMATION

Abstracts should be submitted in electronic form (A4 sheet format, printed with 1 interval).

- ❖ Abstracts should not exceed 2 pages, including figures, tables. The text should be aligned on both sides and typed in Times New Roman 14 pt. Paragraph indent - 10 mm. Figures, schemes should be inserted as an insert Figure MS Word. Mirror fields: top - 20 mm, bottom - 25 mm, left - 30 mm, right - 20 mm. Figures, diagrams, formulas and tables should not go beyond the margins. Pages are not numbered. The text file is submitted in two formats: MS Word and pdf surname author abstracts.doc (or surname author abstracts.rtf MS WORD) surname author abstracts.pdf (for and example, Tkachenko abstracts.doc + Tkachenko abstracts.pdf). The text should be built in the following way:
- ❖ Title of the report in bold capital letters, center alignment.
- Surnames and names of authors in the center of the page (in italics).

- The name of the organization or educational institution in the center of the page.
- ❖ Author's e-mail.
- ❖ Abstract text should begin after one blank line.

Abstracts of reports should be sent before April 01, 2023, to the e-mail of the organizing committee.

Together with the abstracts, a file should be submitted in the format surname_author_application.doc (for example, Tkachenko_application.doc). The application should contain the following information:

- Surname and name of the speaker.
- Academic degree, scientific title, and position of the speaker.
- Title of the report.
- Address for correspondence, E-mail, phone.
- The need to book a hotel room.
