What is Campus Europae?

Campus Europae is a network of universities cooperating to develop new standards of excellence in student exchange and rendering a study year abroad as a normal part of their students' academic careers. Studying abroad is meant to foster students' sense of a European citizenship and allow them to experience Europe's unity in diversity.

And how does it work?

Campus Europae builds upon and is fully compatible with the Erasmus administrative procedures and financing provisions. CE offers students who choose to spend a year abroad in a partner university the possibility to:

- access information on academic equivalences regularly reviewed by the CE subject committees ensuring that credits earned abroad will be fully recognized;
- participate in online and intensive language courses designed to allow them to successfully pursue academic studies in the language of the host university;
- combine their stay abroad with a study related internship in a company or NGO.

Are there any other advantages in going abroad with CE?

Students who have spent two years abroad at two Campus Europae partner universities in two different countries and fulfill certain academic and linguistic criteria; are awarded a Campus Europae Degree by the European University Foundation aimed at singling out graduates with markedly strong academic and intercultural competences. Students who have been one year abroad and fulfill the same criteria can receive a CE Certificate.
